Under this agreement for 2018
Mirani State High School will receive

\$284,723*

This funding will be used to:

- increase the Mean Scale Score (MSS) of Year 9 students for Reading from 536.62 to greater than 575
- increase the MSS of Year 9 students for Writing from 489.88 to 540
- increase the MSS of Year 9 students for Numeracy from 533.74 to 585
- increase the daily attendance rate from 87.8% to greater than 90%.

Our initiatives include:

- providing professional development for staff in literacy and numeracy
- resourcing a non-teaching lead literacy teacher position to work with the Master Teacher to develop resources, coach and monitor literacy in Years 7, 8 and 9
- resourcing additional teacher aide time to facilitate literacy blocks focused on meeting improvement targets
- resourcing additional teacher aide time to track student attendance.

Our school will improve student outcomes by:

Employing additional teacher-aides.	\$165 093
Providing professional development for teachers and teacher aides.	\$18 630
